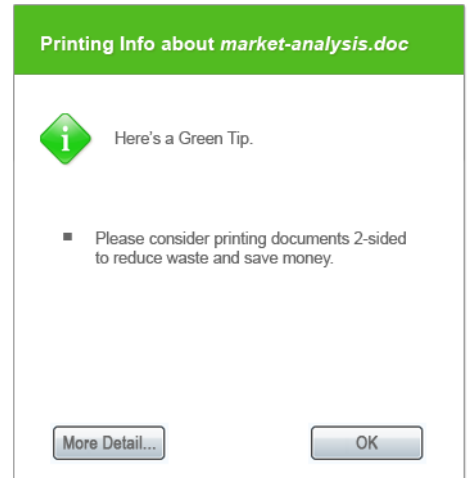

Examples of Policy Print Pop-Ups

Jobs that trigger an **INFORM** action are sent to the printer.

- Policy Print makes a suggestion about how the employee can contribute to cost or waste savings in the future.
- The employee acknowledges the suggestion by clicking OK.
- More details about the underlying print policy are available.



Jobs that trigger a **WARN** action are held until the employee chooses to accept the print policy or override it.

- Policy Print offers two options: continue printing the job or cancel it.
- Continue: The employee must check a box to acknowledge that the job is an exception to policy. The exception is logged and included in a monthly non-compliance report.
- Cancel: The employee's compliance with the policy is logged and included in a monthly savings report.



Jobs that trigger a **DENY** action cannot be printed.

- Policy Print informs the employee that the job violates printing policies and has been canceled.
- The employee is free to resubmit the document with different printing parameters that don't violate policies.
