Pharos Systems has created an updated integration for the BOSCOPE / Virtual Cash network devices. This new integration now runs as its own service and communicates with the Pharos Solution Suite using the External Device Interface (EDI). This new integration supersedes the original Virtual Cash / IPSI integration, which was embedded in the Pharos Print Server service. For more information about the new integration and support versions, please refer to the latest integration documentation.

Effective 12th January 2009, the support status for the original Virtual Cash integration will be changed to the “Mature” support status level¹. The support level change for this integration applies to all versions of the Pharos Solution Suite (i.e. from version 5.1 to 8.0). The original integration will be removed in Pharos Solution Suite 8.1.

Prior to Pharos Solution Suite 8.0, the original Virtual Cash integration was not licensed². The new integration licenses the number of devices that can be connected. Existing customers should contact your reseller or Pharos Systems to determine if any fees apply and obtain the necessary licensing prior to upgrading to the new integration.

At the time of this notice, Pharos Systems does not sell or directly support the Virtual Cash network devices; these devices are sold and supported by Virtual Cash certified vendors. Pharos Systems continues to offer the Omega network terminal device and integrated Multifunction Printers (iMFPs) for print and copy management; for more information, please contact your reseller or Pharos Business Development Manager to learn more about these products.
